Calhoun Middle School Technology Infrastructure Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval for the quote in the amount of \$290,943.51 from Netsync Network Solutions for the purchase of the technology infrastructure for the Calhoun Middle School campus.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This equipment provides the networking electronics, including switches and wireless access points for the campus.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

These products with installation will be purchased through Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Contracts: DIR-TSO-4167, DIR-TSO-4240 and TIPS 230105. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by this project's 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and arrange for delivery and installation in time to coordinate with the construction timeline.
