Girls Basketball:

The girls finished the season 13-11 and are the #6 seed in the Section 2AA South Subsection. The Bucs travel to Mapleton to play Maple River #3 seed tomorrow tonight at 7:00 pm. If we win the quarter final game we would play at Mankato East, Thursday March 3 at @6:00 pm. The Sub Section Championship will be Monday March 7 at MSU and the Section Championship Friday March 11 at MSU. The All-Gopher Conference Selections will be made this Wednesday (3/2/22) and not released until all teams are finished competing.

Boys Basketball:

The boys regular season ends this week with games tonight (at Minnesota Valley Lutheran) and Friday at home vs. Tri-City United. Subsection 2AA seeding is this Wednesday3/2/22. The first game for playoffs will be Tuesday March 8 at the High Seed site. Further rounds follow the same format and locations as the Girls tournaments.
