

District Domain Visual






Strengths

- Strategic planning with Instructional Coaches weekly provided a cohesive alignment both vertically and horizontally
- Rigorous benchmark assessments have proven beneficial in preparing students for state assessments
- TEKS Resource implementation
- Weekly PLC meetings with teachers, administrators, and coaches

Areas for improvement

- Pacing of units, lessons, and instruction
- Consistent utilization of TEA vetted resources
- Small group instruction, reteach, and intervention
- Lesson internalization
- Moving students past Approaches and into Meets and Masters
- 3rd grade lost two ELA teachers in December
