## **NEW BUSINESS**

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act requires each Local Education Agency (LEA) to publicly report progress of the district and its campuses toward meeting the Highly Qualified teacher requirements as defined by the state's measurable highly qualified teacher objectives. Teachers are required to be highly qualified if they are the Teacher of Record providing direct instruction to students in any core academic subject area, including English, reading or language arts, mathematics, science, foreign languages (languages other than English), civics and government, economics, arts, history, and geography. Highly qualified teachers must:

- Hold at least a bachelor's degree;
- Be fully certified to teach in Texas; and
- Demonstrate competency in their core academic subject area.

As of the September 16, 2014 reporting timeline, Valley Mills ISD campus data are as follows:
