## Re:-RFP #TX170120CPC awarded by Pride Performance Consulting LLC/Prospering Pals Cooperative Renewal: July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019

On May 22, 2017, The Board of Trustees awarded the RFP's listed below to the recommended suppliers for the Prospering Pals Child Nutrition Cooperative for the 2017-18 Fiscal Year. The terms of the awarded RFP's were for one year with three one-year renewal options to be exercised at the discretion of the District.

All bids were sent out as part of the Prospering Pals Purchasing Cooperative. Prospering Pals is a purchasing cooperative hosted and managed by Coppell ISD, and includes twenty seven (27) school districts in our area. This cooperative was formed several years ago in order to increase the purchasing power of Coppell ISD and all other respective school districts who are a part of the Prospering Pals Cooperative.

CISD Recommendation: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees authorize CISD Administration to execute the renewal agreements for the first of the three one-year options, as well as, any subsequent renewals, not to exceed four years in the aggregate, as long as the suppliers continue to meet the needs of the District, our Students, and the Prospering Pals Cooperative.
