- 1. Intervention aides will be hired to work with groups of students who need help filling learning gaps in the areas of ELA, math and science as well as learn to use technology more effectively. (\$45,697)
- 2. Software and licenses will be purchased that are designed to help identify and fill learning gaps that our EDA students have in the areas of math, ELA and science. We are going to purchase licenses so that students have access to Read 180 program as well as access to the programs MobyMax, Reflex math and Generation Genius. (\$13,260)
- 3. Access to mClass Acadience Math for 4th and 5th grade will be purchased so that teachers can easily track and progress monitor student growth. (\$200)
- 4. Since our students will be using technology to help fill some learning gaps a technology specialist will be utilized to assist students in gaining and maintaining access to the various programs during the school day. This individual will spend at least 75% of their time with students. (\$1,500)
- 5. Money will be used to provide professional development to teachers and/or instructional aides to improve student success in the areas of ELA, math and science. This would include traveling to locations outside of Roosevelt, Utah for professional development in the areas of instruction, classroom management, interventions, professional learning communities, response to intervention, school improvement, and school excellence. (\$5,017)
