PLACE Bench PAD 72" X 30"

Concrete will be 5" thick.
Compacted stone base, reinforced wire mesh, #4 rebar, as needed,
and control joints are installed to help control cracking.

All material is guaranteed to be as specified, and the above work to be performed in accordance with the drawings and specifications submitted for above work and completed in a substantial workmanlike manner for the sum of \$ 950-

Payment to be made as follows: 50% of total price due at end of first work day, remaining 50% due upon day of concrete pour.

Any alteration or deviation from above specifications, including unforeseen wire or thickened slab during removal, will become an extra charge over and above the estimate, and will be executed only upon written or verbal order. All agreements contingent upon strikes, accidents, or delays beyond our control.

Not responsible for landscape, or cracking, flaking, discoloration, scaling, or pop outs on the surface of the concrete due to the quality of the redimix or salts and not due to the work of the contractor.
