## Student Accident Insurance

May 28, 2019

### SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of RFP #1904-13 Student Insurance Plans for 2019-2020.

### BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management... In Pursuit of excellence, we will

- Promote health, wellness and emotional wellbeing
- Adjust policies and procedures to address the rapid growth and changing demographics, nurturing our strong sense of community.

### PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

On May 22, 2018, the Board approved Texas Student Resources/Health Special Risk, Inc. as the company providing student insurance with Starr Indemnity & Liability as carrier and Kent Holbert as agent for a period of 12 months.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

According to Attorney General Opinion DM418 (1996) insurance is included in the term "personal property". This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

This proposal was issued on March 31, 2019. Ninety-five (95) vendors were notified. Three (3) responses were received on April 18, 2019. All responding vendors were evaluated by a committee based upon the published criteria within the RFP document. The evaluation committee consisted of members from the Risk Management, Athletic and Purchasing Departments.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The proposal offered by Student Insurance Plans is \$105,552 (\$95,000 plus \$7,475 catastrophic coverage and \$3,077 for optional \$500,000 Cash Benefit Option). The combined premium for 2018-2019 through Texas Student Resources/Health Special Risk, Inc. was \$115,373. This is a decrease of \$9,821 for 2019-2020.

### BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Provide UIL Insurance coverage and Student Accident Insurance for 2019-2020 school year.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the RFP #1904-13 Student Accident Insurance response from Student Insurance Plans in the amount of \$105,552 (\$95,000 plus \$7,475 catastrophic coverage and \$3,077 for optional \$500,000 Cash Benefit Option) for an annual premium for the term July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 with the option of two (2) additional one - year renewal terms, with a two year rate guarantee upon governing board approval, be awarded to Catlin Insurance Company as the Carrier and Student Insurance Plans LLC as the agent.
