The Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act allows the Board of Education ~~has a responsibility to minimize protect itself against the risk of injuries to persons and property damage or any liability or loss associated with its operations which may be imposed upon it or one of its employees for a tortious act under Federal or State common or statutory law, the Workers' Compensation Act, the Workers' Occupational Diseases Act, or the Unemployment Insurance Act by, among other things, risk management directly attributable to loss prevention and loss reduction and educational, inspectional, and supervisory services directly relating to loss prevention and loss reduction.~~ A safe learning and working environment benefits students attending ~~the District~~ schools ~~operated by the District~~, employees of the District, and members of the general public ~~affected by the operations of the District.~~

In order ~~To to~~ protect the assets of the District and to promote the health, safety and welfare of those affected by its operations, the Board hereby establishes this comprehensive risk management program intended to prevent and reduce the exposure of the District to the risk of liability or loss which may be imposed upon the District or upon its employees acting within the scope of their employment on behalf of the District.

The District can best prevent and reduce its exposure to liability or loss through a systematic effort to identify and minimize the conditions which lead to personal injuries and property damage as a result of the operations of the District. This risk management program is designed both to achieve the purpose of minimizing risk and to provide a means of defraying the costs associated with implementation of the program.
