PLAN OF ACTION

Alamo exceeds the cap by one student in grade two. Normal attrition should balance the class load by the end of the year. Also, the campus is a total magnet campus with no designated attendance zone. The enrollment can be controlled through magnet school acceptance.

Blackshear exceeds the cap by four students in kindergarten. Magnet student enrollment will be closely monitored in kindergarten and first grade to prevent enrollment exceeding the cap at these grade levels.

Burnet exceeds the cap by one student in grade one. Normal attrition should balance the class load by the end of the semester.

Murry Fly exceeds the cap by two students in grade three. Normal attrition should balance the class load by the end of the year. Also, construction scheduled for 2007-2008 includes the addition of classroom space. This will allow for future increases in student population.

Jordan exceeds the cap by five students in grade four. Construction scheduled for 2008-2009 includes the addition of classroom space. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2007-2008 school year.

Pease exceeds the cap by two students in grade one. Construction scheduled for 2007-2008 includes the addition of classroom space. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2007-2008 school year while awaiting the completion of construction.

San Jacinto exceeds the cap by one student in kindergarten (bilingual class) and two students in grade three (bilingual class). Construction scheduled for 2007-2008 includes the addition of classroom space. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2007-2008 school year while awaiting the completion of construction.

Zavala exceeds the cap by three students in kindergarten. Magnet student enrollment will be closely monitored in kindergarten and first grade to prevent enrollment exceeding the cap at these grade levels. Also, the construction scheduled for 2007-2008 includes the addition of classroom space. This will allow for future increases in student population.

Additional Note: Ireland exceeds the cap by eight students in grade three. A new teaching position has been added to reduce the class-size. Therefore, a waiver is not requested for this campus.
