Background Information

As part of the 2023 Bond Proposition B, the district, in conjunction with LAN, is undertaking the replacement and upgrade of classroom teaching and learning technologies for all instructional spaces. The request for proposal contains five portions: (1) interactive flat panel, (2) laptop computer, (3) document camera, (4) mobile teaching station, and a (5) mobile charging solution. A request for proposals (RFP#24-25.003) was issued on December 11, 2025 with a pre-proposal conference on December 18, 2025 and closing on January 24, 2025. The district received 17 bids from 14 vendors, with nine staff members on the selection committee.

Two bids were disqualified for not meeting proposal requirements, leaving 15 bids for initial evaluation. Four bids advanced to a second round of on-site demonstrations and scoring on February 25 and 27, 2025. The request for proposal is being awarded to three vendors, with the five portions split among them to secure the best pricing and meet the district's needs.

- Part 2: Laptop Computer: Lenovo Yoga 13W from UDT (\$775,188.50)
- Part 3: Document Camera: IPEVO VZ-R Ultra from Global Asset (\$283,223.50)
- Part 4: Mobile Teaching Station: Hovercam Pilot Air Custom from Bluum (\$1,406,227.79)
- Part 5: Mobile Charging Solution: Bretford Cube Cart from UDT (\$314,617.50)

All prices are presented as "not to exceed" amounts based on 950 classrooms.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve as presented the purchase of classroom teaching and learning technologies in excess of \$50,000.
