- 1. Summary of changes to the existing school safety plans and drill plans as recommended at the Annual Review meeting(s):
 - A. During the 2024-2025 school year, all seven campuses conducted all required safety drills, and that documentation was submitted to the ROE on April 13, 2025.
 - B. The district began implementing year 1 of the District Improvement Plan, specifically, these items are related to safety:
 - By September 30, 2024 RCS will begin implementation of at least quarterly building perimeter checks.
 - Quarters 1-3 have been completed. Officer Kraft will conduct Quarter 4 this week
 PA/PreK exterior door numbers
 - By December 1, 2024 RCS will update the existing Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).
 - This was completed and copies shared with all schools and first responders.
 - By January 31, 2025, the district will have a comprehensive emergency reunification plan in place.
 - District is prepared for the reunification plan as outlined in the EOP-Standard Response Protocol.
 - Discuss implementation of reunification drill.
 - July/August drill with Admin/Clericals .
 - After July 29th (Kraft is
