

## **SUMMARY OF RULES AMENDMENTS**

### **DIVISION OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION RULES GOVERNING HOME SCHOOLS**

The proposed amendments to these rules incorporate provisions of Act 623 of 2021, First, it reduced from fourteen (14) days to five (5) days the notice period a parent or guardian must provide to a school district before withdrawing their child for home schooling. (The law still provides, however, that the notice period may be waived by the school district). Second, it provided that if a student is enrolled in a public school that temporarily issued items, resources, supplies, materials, or other property to the student, the student is not eligible for home school enrollment until the items are returned, paid for, or the semester has ended. These amendments incorporate those two provisions. Non-substantive technical and editorial changes also were made.

#### **Post Public Comment**

No substantive changes were made to the proposed rules as a result of public comment. Only one minor technical change was made.
