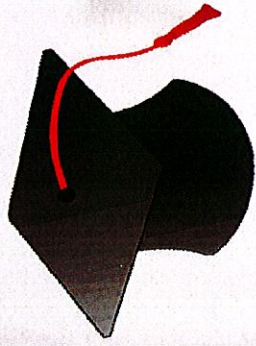

Mission Statement

The mission of the Pregnancy, Education, and Parenting (PEP) Program is to enable school-age parents, through education, to become self-sufficient, responsible, job-oriented citizens. The Program's goal is to reduce the number of students who drop out of school due to pregnancy and/or parenthood and to recover young parents who are 21 years old or younger to the educational system.

Program Components

- ❖ Individual counseling, peer counseling, and self-help programs;
- ❖ Career counseling and job-readiness training;
- ❖ Child care for the students' children at a child care facility in close proximity to the home or campus;
- ❖ Transportation for children of students to and from the campus or child care facility;
- ❖ Transportation for students, as appropriate, to and from the campus or child care facility;
- ❖ Instruction related to knowledge and skills in child development, parenting and home and family living; and
- ❖ Assistance to students in the program in obtaining available services from government agencies or community service organizations, including prenatal and postnatal health and nutrition programs

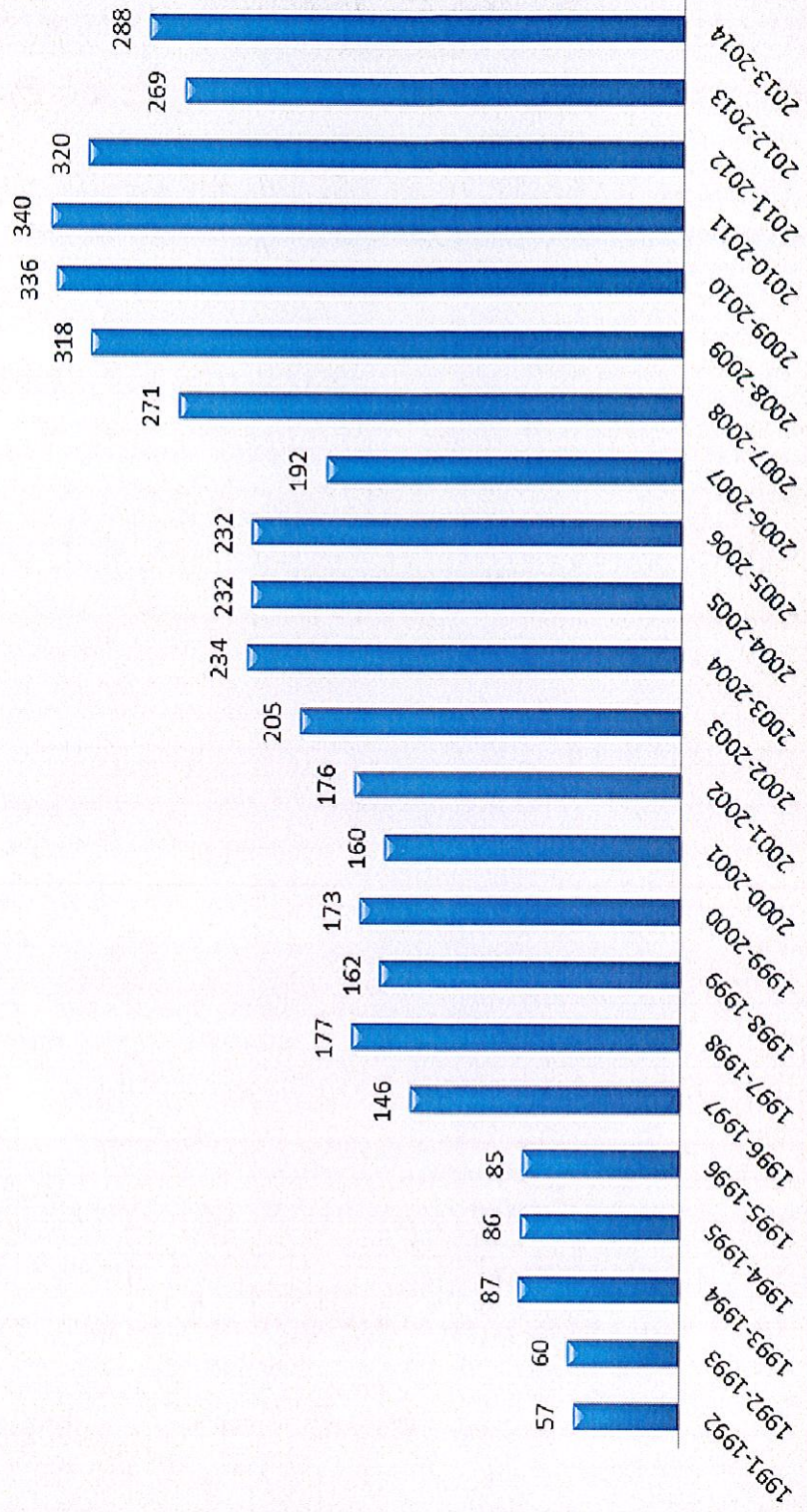

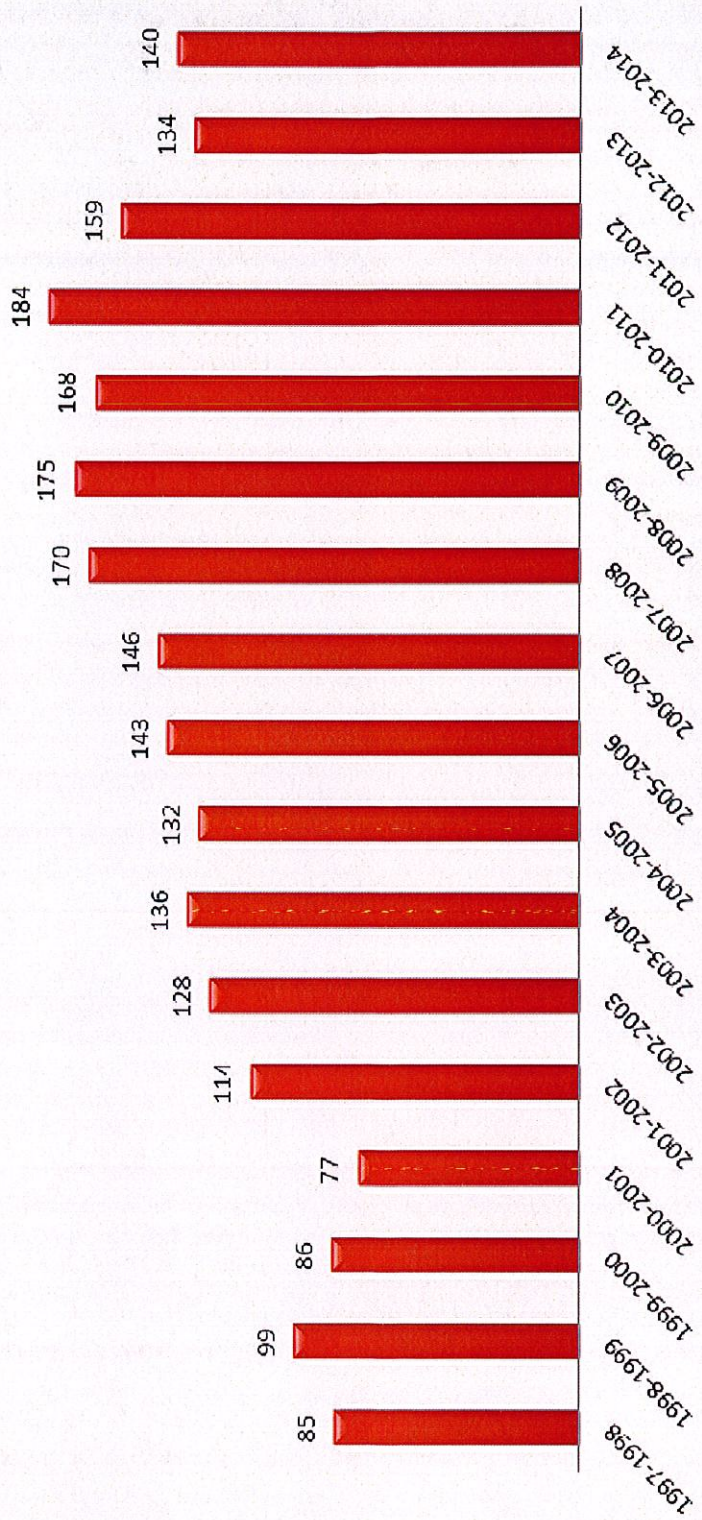
UISD PEP PROGRAM PREGNANT AND/OR PARENTING PARTICIPANTS 1991-2014
