BACKGROUND:

The District Education Improvement Committee (DEIC), as required by the Texas Education Code, meets regularly during the academic year. The Division of School Improvement and Support at the TEA is responsible for the state level administration of the school improvement program under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The Division provides statewide leadership for the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) flexibility principle.

The District Improvement Plan sets the District’s Goals and Performance Objectives and outlines the greatest needs and strongest strategies to address those identified needs. Local education agencies (LEAs) must use funds to provide adequate resources to support academic success of all students based on the identified and prioritized needs. The primary function of categorical funds is to close the achievement gaps between groups of students by requiring greater accountability and offering increased flexibility and choice. The 2024-2025 District Improvement Plan is submitted to the Board of Trustees for approval of the goals and performance objectives.
