Why are we considering boundary adjustment?

- Elmonica Elementary School has experienced a steady increase in enrollment,
- Since 2012, enrollment has grown from 584 students to 757 (+29%) which has exceeded its permanent building and portable classroom capacity.
- The District has installed 13 portable classrooms – two in 2018
- During the same period, Beaver Acres and McKinley Elementary Schools, which are adjacent to Elmonica, have experience a decline in enrollment.

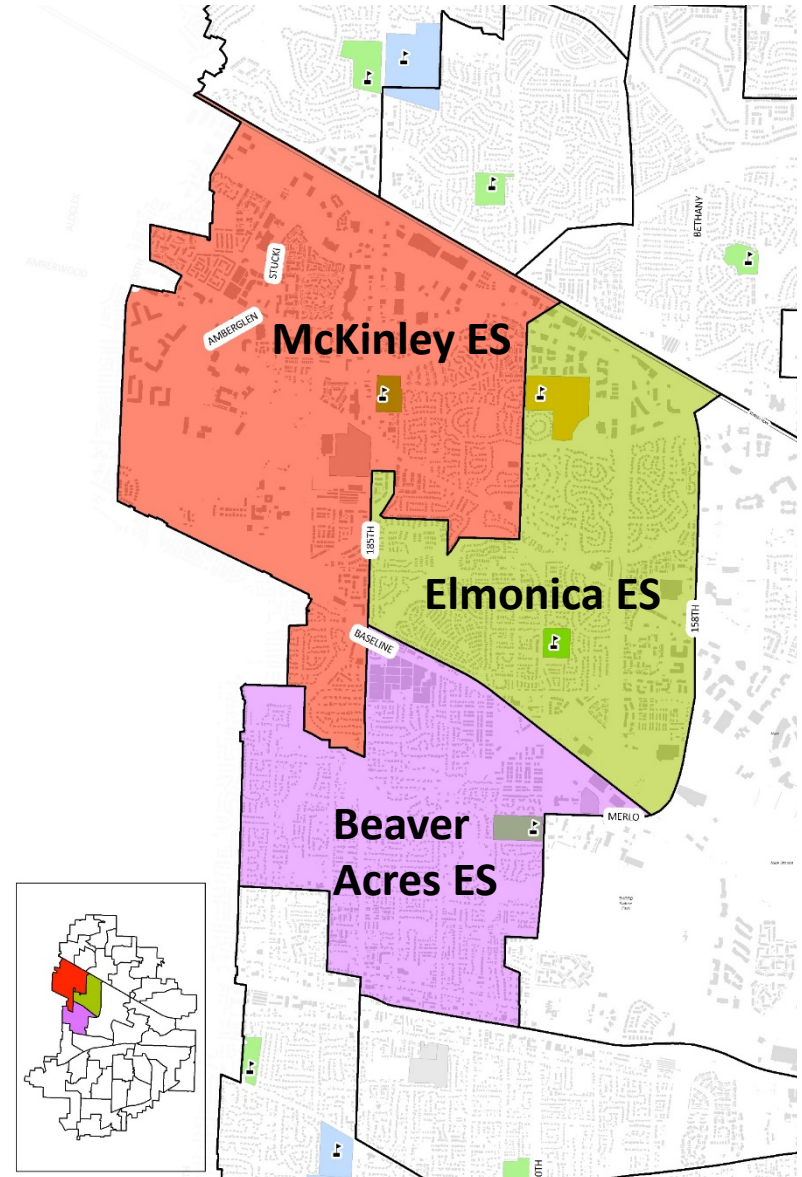
Board Objectives for the Boundary Adjustment Process

To initiate the process, the School Board adopted two objectives:

- **Objective 1:** Create an attendance boundary amendment that will provide overcrowding relief for Elmonica Elementary School for the 2019-20 school year.
- **Objective 2:** To the degree feasible, balance future enrollment with each affected school's capacity.

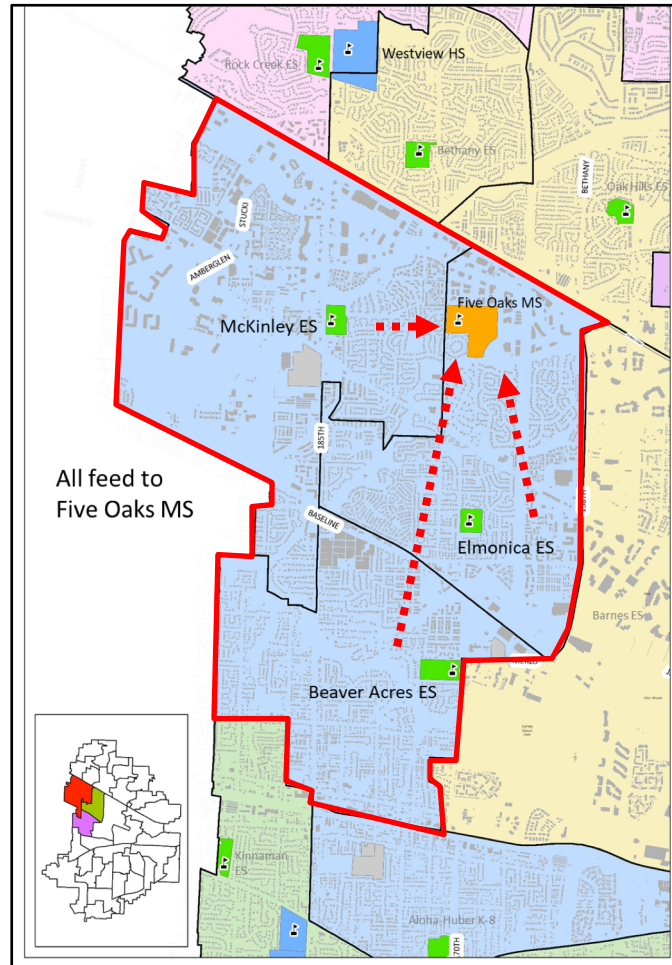
Demographic & Enrollment Overview

- Three elementary schools included in the boundary adjustment study

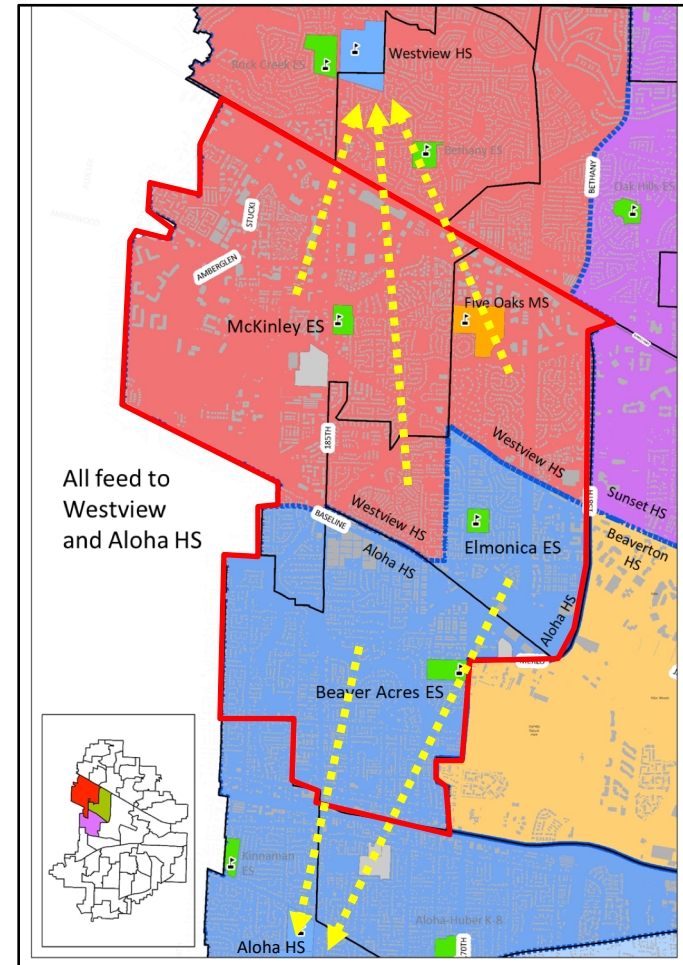


Feeder Patterns to Middle & High School

All feed to Five Oaks MS

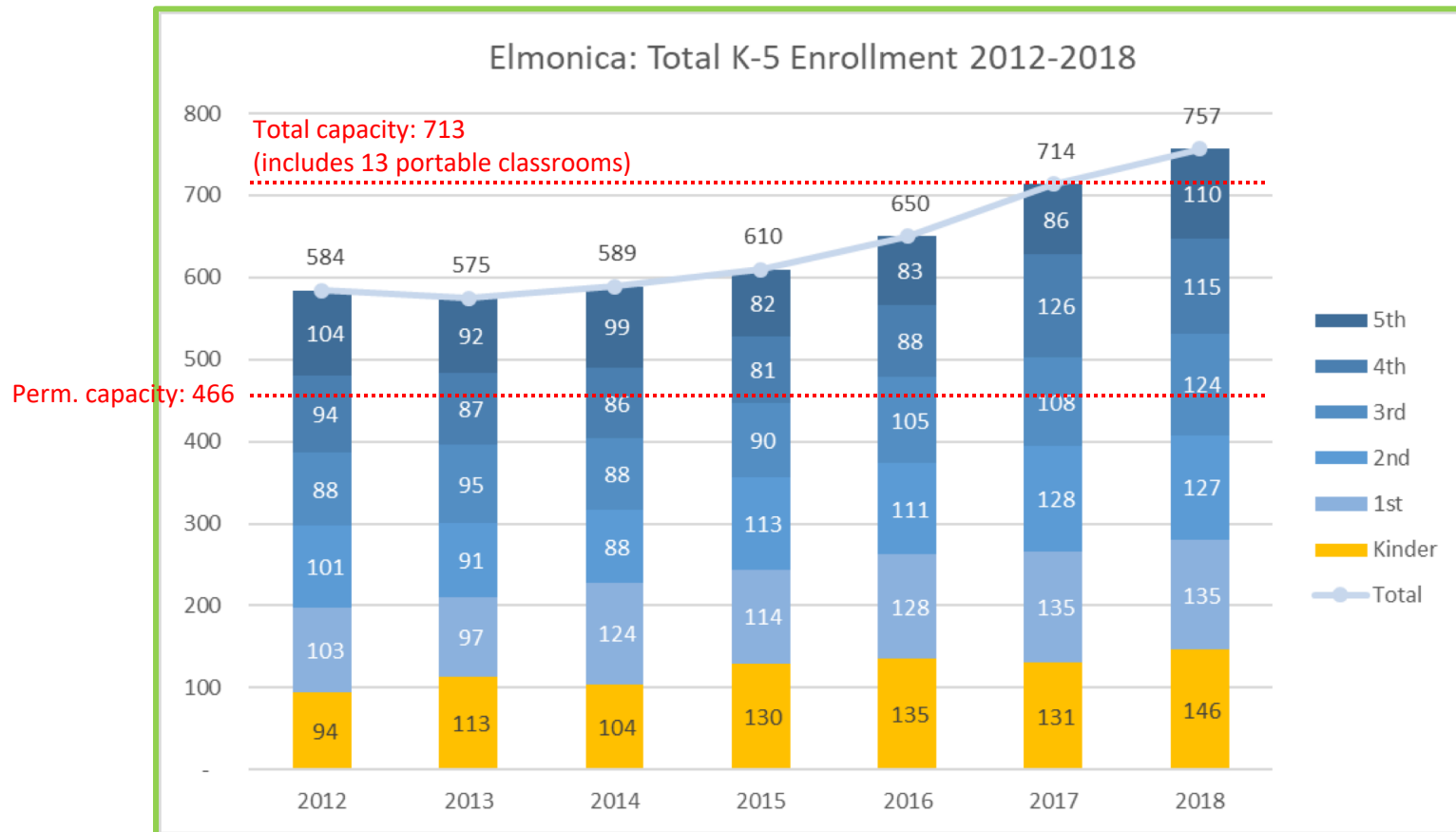
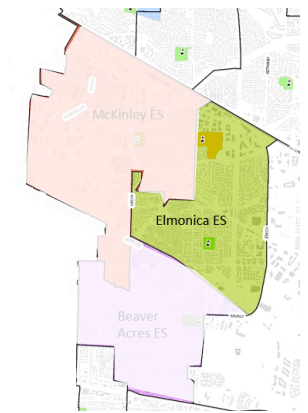


Portions Feed to Westview or Aloha HS



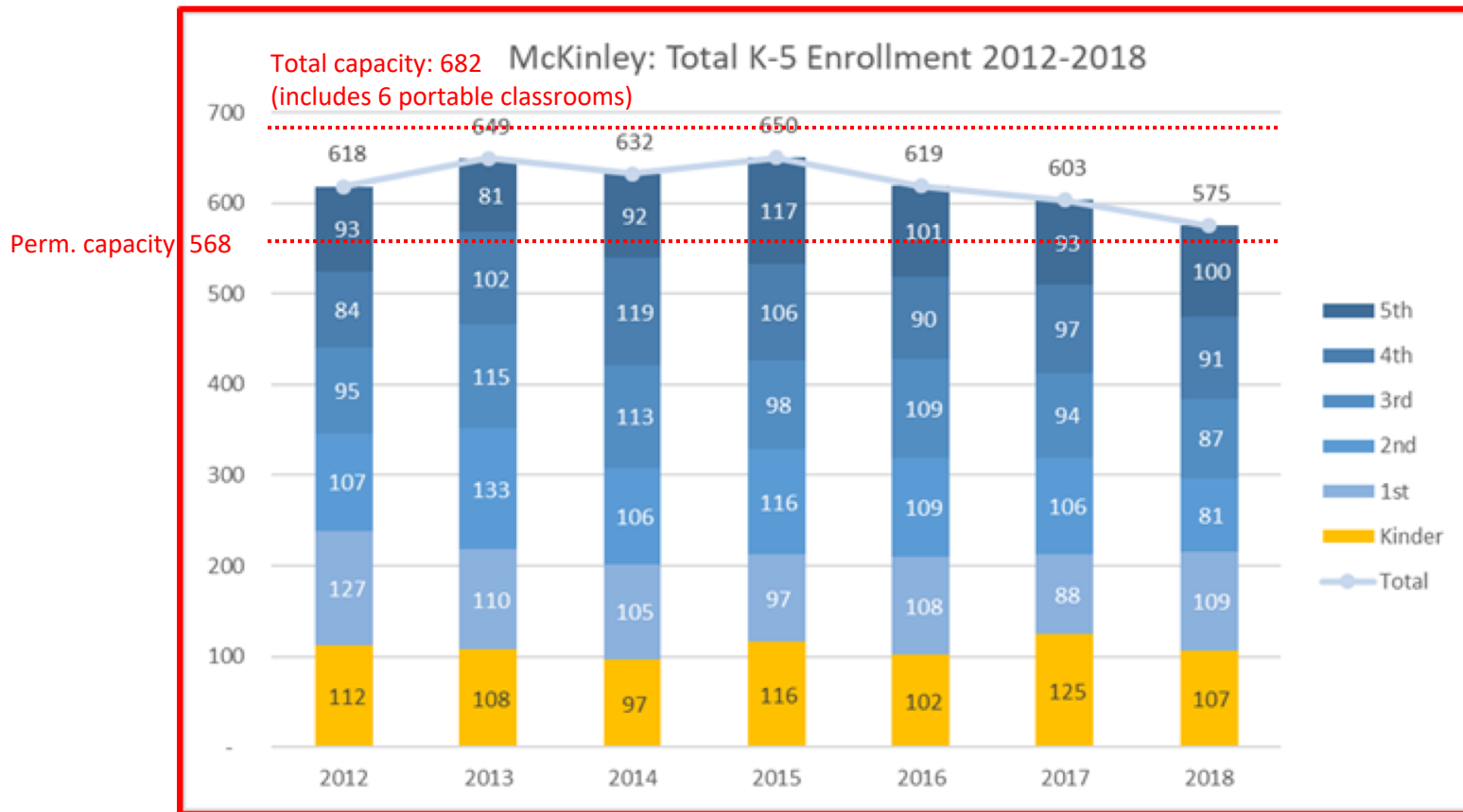
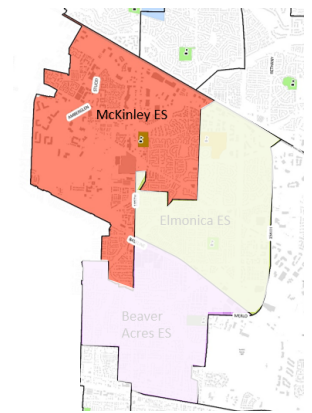
Elmonica Elementary Enrollment: 2012 to 2018

- Have added portable capacity



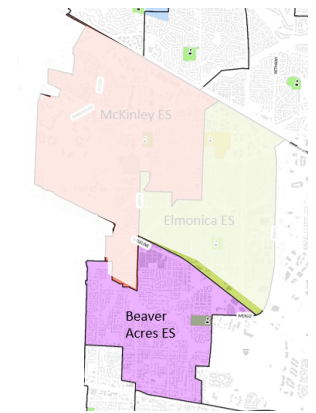
McKinley Elementary Enrollment: 2012 to 2018

- Enrollment declines beginning 2016



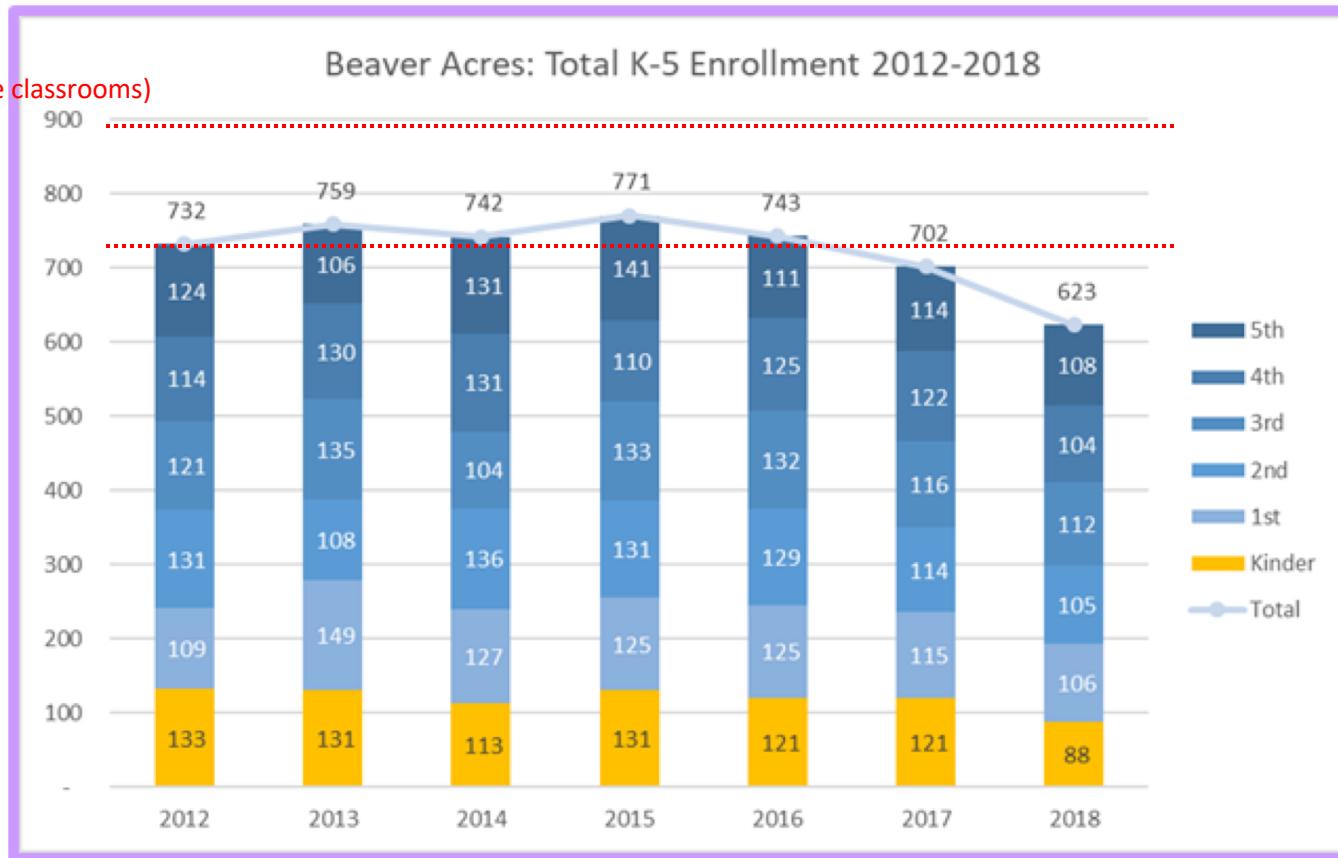
Beaver Acres Elementary Enrollment: 2012 to 2018

(includes 8 portable classrooms)

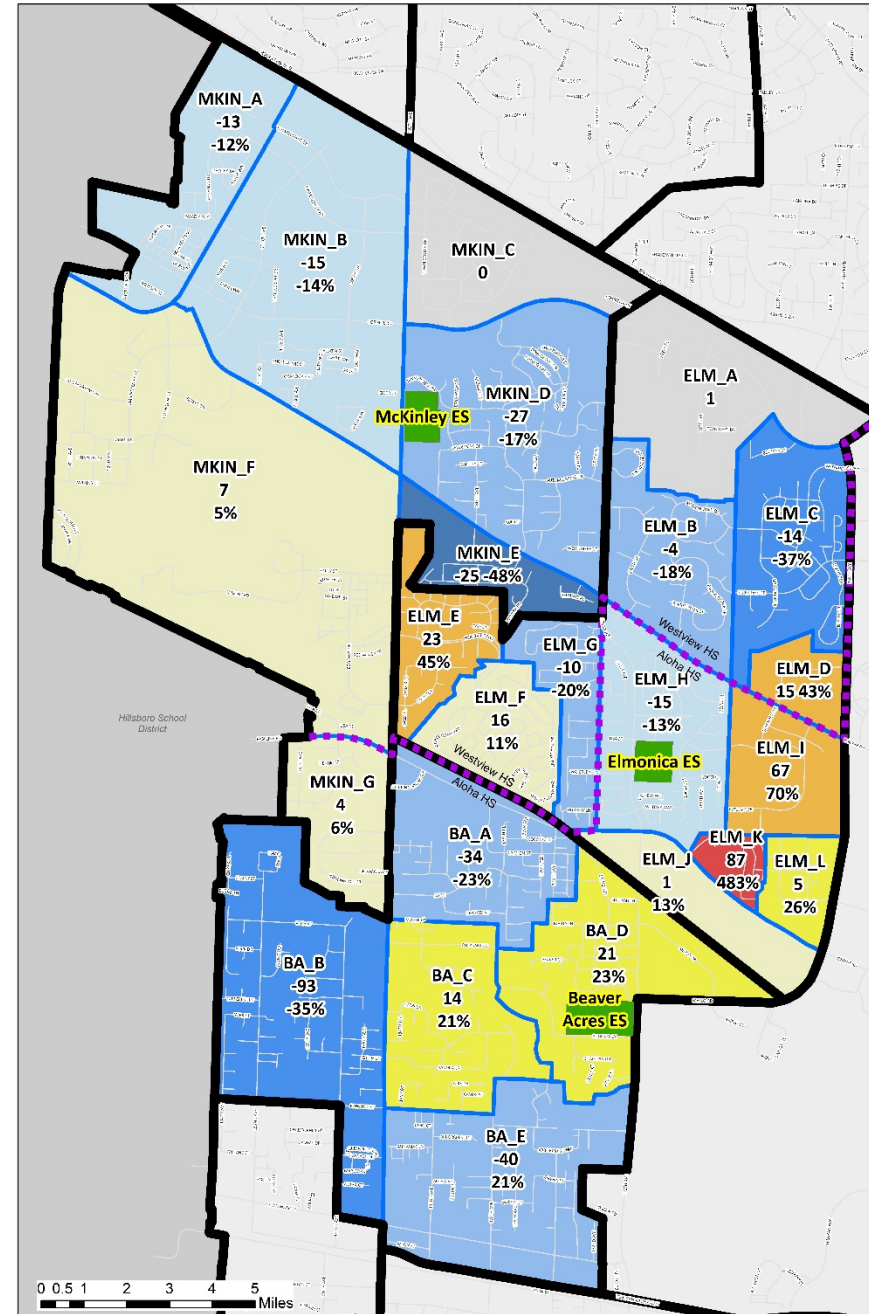
Perm. capacity: 741

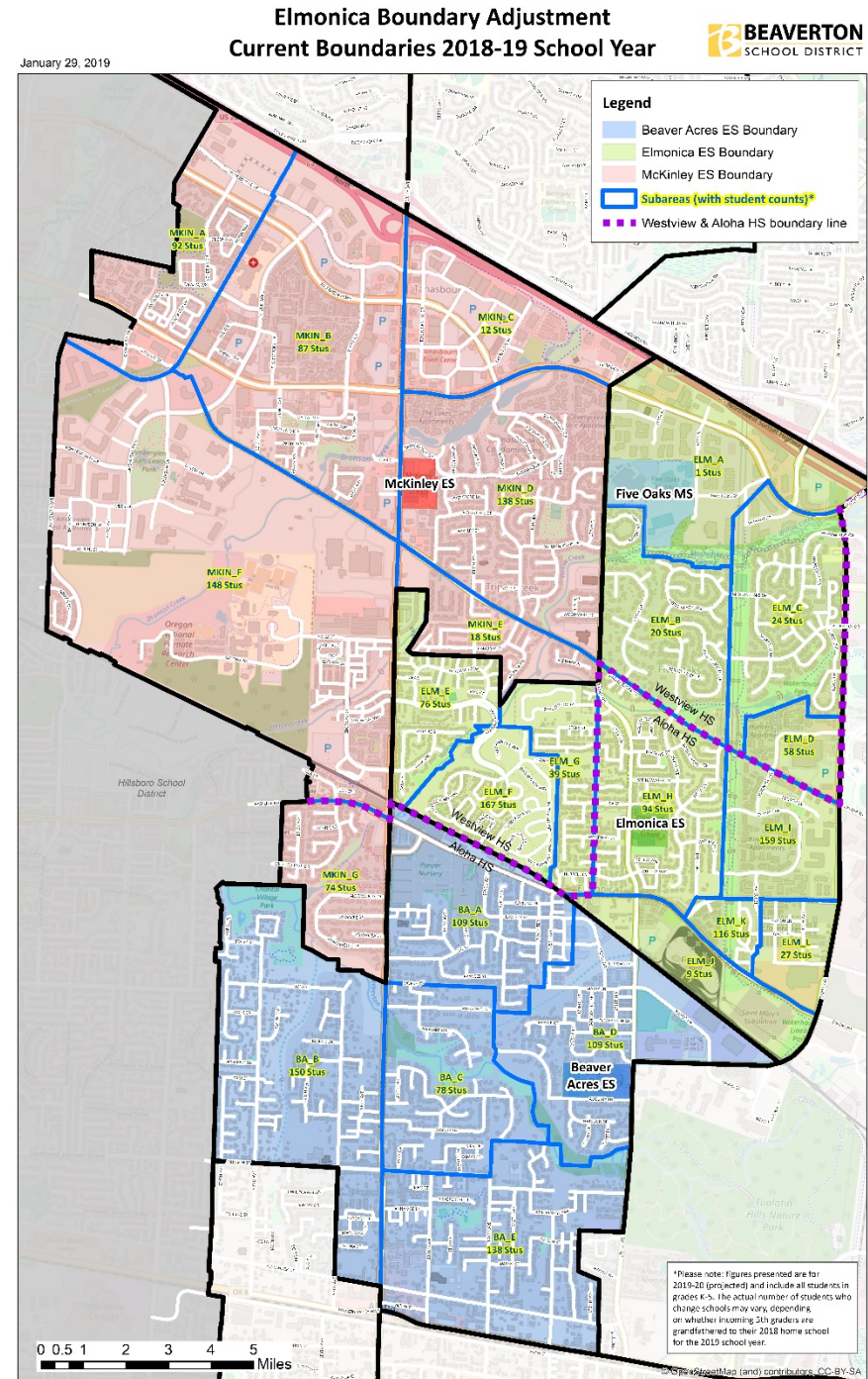
K-5 Population Change 2014 to 2018

- Elmonica has experienced more growth, in part due to new residential development



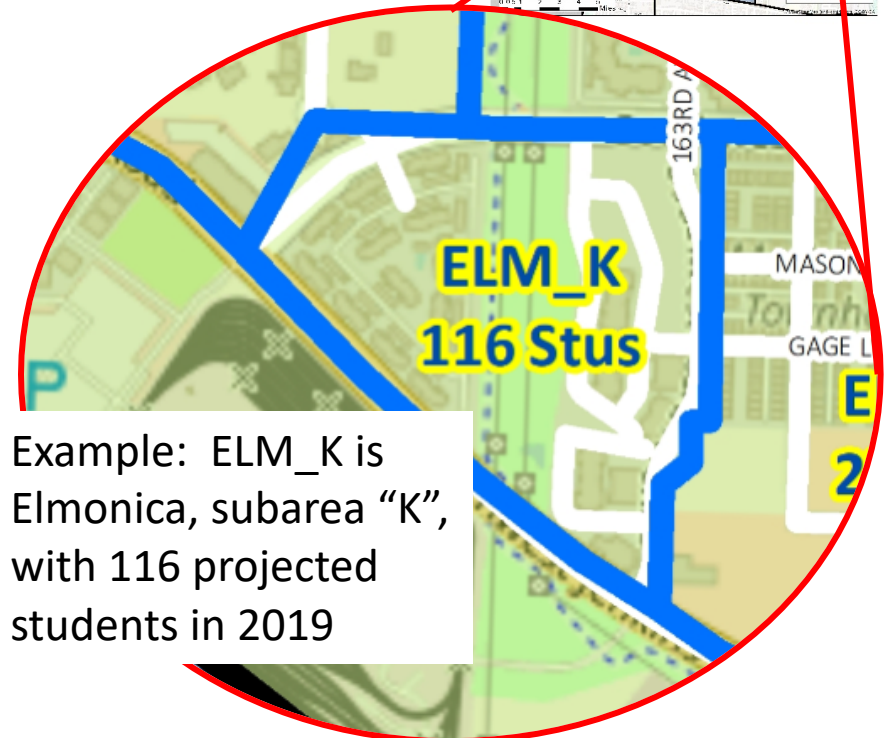
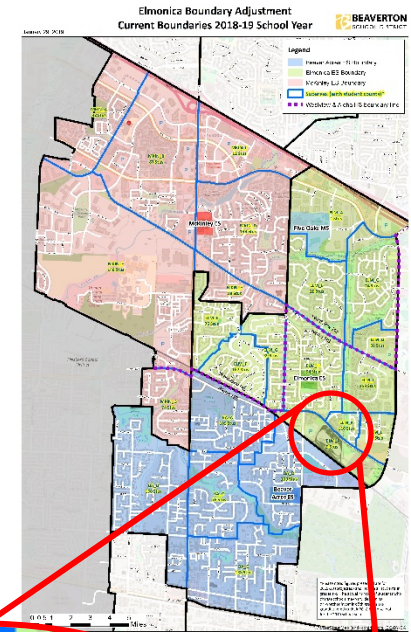
Boundary Advisory Committee's Workmap

Workmap “Subareas”

- Each elementary school is divided into portions
- Labeled by school with an alphabetical designation
- Shows the number of K-5 students projected for the 2019-20 school year
- Approximately how many students would be moved if shifted to another boundary
- Staff can assist in tabulating the result of moves
