SUBJECT:         Consider Resolution to Suspend Portions of EIA (Local)                                  
        for the 2011-12 School Year                                

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**ACTION**  
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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Texas Education Code requires a school district to adopt a policy that requires a student's performance on an end-of-course (EOC) assessment instrument to account for 15 percent of a student's final grade for the course.

The Commissioner of Education has given school districts the ability to defer implementation for the 2011-12 school year of the statutory provision that requires performance on an EOC assessment to count as 15 percent of a student's final course grade.

**ITEM ADDRESSED:**

We would like to suspend for the remainder of the 2011-12 school year this portion of the following code:

EIA (LOCAL), at END-OF-COURSE ASSESSMENTS, requiring a student's performance on an EOC assessment to count for 15 percent of a student's final grade for the course as reported on the students transcript.
