Maggie Furst, 82 survived the horrors of the Holocaust when her mother obtained visas to London for Maggie and her brother. Maggie lived most of her life in New York City and then moved to Dallas, where she met her husband of 59 years. Most of her extended family perished in the Holocaust under Hitler's rule.
