

SPRING BREAK EMPLOYEE FEEDBACK

Responses from Staff in the Schools:

All school administrators indicated that there are employees in their building who want to keep Spring Break the week in March when it has traditionally been held, and employees in their building who would like to see it held a week later going into April.

To glean more insight, a survey was sent out to district employees on April 7, 2025.

Survey Results:

110 of the 308 employees responded with a preference

25 people (22.7% of respondents) indicated keep it on the last of March [3/23-3/26]

66 people (60.0% of respondents) want it changed to the first of April [3/30-4/2]

19 people (17.3% of respondents) stated they have no preference

Some employees chose to leave comments to provide an understanding or rationale of choice.
