# **Addressing The Existing Deficit**

#### Administration proposals to tackle the \$12 million deficit.

- 1. Freeze hiring for non-critical position since January 4th, 2023
- 2. Closed the following positions:
  - a. Deputy Superintendent
  - b. Executive Director of Student Support Services
  - c. Director of Instructional Technology and Media Services
  - d. Instructional Technology Coordinator
  - e. Advanced Academics Coordinator
  - f. Assistant Principal Carrillo Elementary
  - g. Assistant Principal Kindred Elementary
  - h. Instructional Coach Abraham Middle School
  - i. Director of Facilities

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- 3. Adjusted the cut-off of purchase orders to an earlier date to reduce non-payroll expenditures (Changed from 08/15 to 05/05)
- 4. Changed the budgeting methodology from zero based budgeting to student allocation-based budgeting to tie budget to enrollment
- 6. Applied and got awarded \$2.7 million in three Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) to address the district technology needs instead of using General Fund
- 7. Actively seeking out partnership and donation with local entities to reduce expenditures
- 8. Proposed to consolidate four campuses Kazen MS, Kindred ES, Athens ES, and West Campus HS

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- 9. Decrease the campus/department budgets by 10% each year since 2022-2023
- 10. Reclassifying district based positions to grant/federal funding
- 11. Scaling back on supplemental academic programs
- 12. Increase average daily attendance rate to generate more revenue.

From 86% - 6,454 ADA in 2021-2022 to 90.32% - 6,700 ADA in 2022-2023 (estimated)
