Board Report June 17, 2020

21st Century “Isskonatappi” Program is currently providing online distance learning services for grades 2nd – 12th grade. A plan has been set in place for a Student Service-Learning Program for High School students, this program will employ up to 30 High School Students for the month’s June & July. Due the Covid-19 Pandemic all precautions will be taken.

21st CCLC Online learning - tutors will continue to be in contact with their students/families by phone, email and google classroom. They will provide Tutorial Services, STEM Activities and College/Career Prep through distance learning.

STEM Activities (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics will be sent out weekly, we will be using a lot of Science projects. All STEM Projects will be based on common everyday household items to ensure every student will be able to participate, here is a list of a few projects *Lava *Volcano making *Playdough *Paper Rockets *Skittles Experiment.

- Cooking - Basic cooking/baking recipes (age/grade appropriate)
- Art’s and Craft’s projects ranging from drawing, coloring, building towers and painting projects.
- Poetry/art exhibit- Online
- Gardening – Gardening project/Guides for student (families) 7 fun container Garden projects.
- Exercising – weekly exercise calendar
- Google Earth – Virtual Tours of historic places from around the world.

21st CCLC Student Service-Learning Program (Outline of Activities)

Culture Week

- Learning where Berry Soup came from
- Contacting Antelope Consulting (Traditional plants)
- Traditional Games and Medicine

Culinary Arts Week

- learning to cook with basic affordable foods.
- Visiting the local commodity house.
- Implementing nutritional component
- Using measuring techniques

Clean Up Week

- The local pond, Dead Dog Lake, removing the trash
- Solid Waste visit to show our students how they divided up the trash.
- Adopt a highway here on the reservation or a surrounding area.
- Paint over graffiti in our community.
- Yard work for elders.
- Plant flowers

All staff will be required to wear a mask and gloves at all times while working.

All Staff/Students will be required to attend a covid-19 and social distance day training

Pre-Activity Screening

- A check in station will be established
- All adults and students will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to an activity
- Responses to screening questions for each person will be recorded and stored so that there is a record of everyone present in case a participant develops COVID-19 symptoms.

All 21st CCLC staff have been attending Professional Development trainings/webinars weekly through (Zoom) hosted by 21st CCLC Michelle Cusey & Y4Y US Edu. Dept. They just finished up a two series Trauma Informed training.

Our plan at this point is to continue providing services through distance learning until the end of June 2020. Our student service-learning program will continue until the end of July 2020.
