As per 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §109.1001(o), the school district is required to hold a public hearing on the district's *Financial Management Performance Rating*, or the "**School FIRST**" Rating (*Financial Accountability Rating System of Texas*) provided by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). The Rating is based on a comparison of indicators established by the Commissioner of Education. During the hearing, the public will have the opportunity to make comments on the district's *Financial Rating*.

As a requirement, the first *Notice* for this *Public Hearing* may not be placed more than 30 days or less than 14 days prior to the hearing. The district has met this requirement.
