5. The Secretary of the Board is authorized and directed to publish notice of the election and to publish notice of the polling places for the election, as required by law.

6. The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to offer the proposed bond issue described in the budget for public sale.

## PROPOSED BUDGET OF EXPENDITURES WITH TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019 TO AND INCLUDING JUNE 30, 2020

Code Ann. § 6-13-622 has prepared, approved and hereby makes public the proposed budget of expenditures, together with the tax rate, as follows:

- 2. Instructional Expense
- 3. Maintenance and Operation Expense
- 4. Dedicated Maintenance and Operation Expenditures
- 5. Pupil Transportation Expense
- 6. Other Operating Expense
- 7. Non-Bonded Debt Payment
- 8. Bonded Debt Payment
- 9. Building Fund Expense

To provide for the foregoing proposed budget of expenditures, the Board of Directors proposes a total school tax rate (state and local) of \_\_\_\_ mills on the dollar of the assessed value of taxable property located in this School District. The proposed tax includes the uniform rate of tax of 25.0 mills (the "Statewide Uniform Rate") to be collected on all taxable property in the State and remitted to the State Treasurer pursuant to Amendment No. 74 to the Arkansas Constitution to be used solely for maintenance and operation of schools in the State. As provided in Amendment No. 74, the Statewide Uniform Rate replaces a portion of the existing rate of tax levied by this School District and available for maintenance and operation of schools in this District. The total proposed school tax levy of \_\_\_\_ mills includes 25.0 mills specifically voted for general maintenance and operation, \_\_\_\_ mills voted for debt service previously voted as a continuing levy pledged for the retirement of existing bonded indebtedness and new debt service mill.
