Consider Approval of Submission for the TEA Staff Development Waiver for 2100 Minutes for the 2025-2026 School Year

Background:

CCISD is requesting permission to submit a Staff Development Waiver to TEA. Effective with the 2018-2019 school year, TEA began offering a staff development waiver that provides for a maximum of 2100 total waiver minutes to use for professional learning. Districts may choose how to apply their approved waiver minutes - early release, late arrival, all day staff development or a combination. This waiver will also allow some flexibility in the event it is necessary to miss instruction due to weather or other circumstances. These waiver minutes are for staff development in place of instruction; and the district calendar has many of these days already built in. The DEIC approved moving forward to the Board with this recommendation on February 18, 2025.
