Staff - 47 responses



Parent Survey Highlight - Positive Learning Environment


Count of The learning environment at this school is positive.





Parent Survey Highlight - Communication


Count of I am well-informed about my child's progress in school.





Student Survey Highlight - My Teacher Cares


Count of My teachers really care about me.





Student Survey Highlight - Communication


Count of My teachers communicate with my parents.





Staff Survey Highlight - Strong Relationships


Count of Teachers at this school build strong relationships with students.

Count of Students in this school are receiving a high-quality education.






Growth Areas



Parent Survey Growth Area - Peer Relations


Count of My child has encountered harassment or teasing at school this year.





Student Survey Growth Area - Peer Relations


Count of Most students in my school really care about each other.

Action Plan and Next Steps



2019-2020 School Year

- Core Academic teachers have a common planning time daily to increase parent communication, student communication, review data and discuss student concerns.
- Weekly Child Study Team meetings with grade level teachers, social worker, and school counselors.
- School counselors teaching seminar classes daily to all 7th and 8th grade students with a focus on college and career readiness and social emotional learning.
- Two Culture and Climate Specialists that focus on student relationships and behavior.
- Administration and counselors assigned to hallways to support student needs on a more immediate basis.

Throughout 2019-2020 school year the DMS staff will be working together to analyze school wide practices and determine areas of focus as we apply for the Commissioner's Network.
