Summer 2018 - General

Total Project Budget for 2017-2018 is \$16m.

LS 2018 budget is what is left over after 2017 summer work and Holmes addition (\$8,760,000). Current scope identified as follows:

- 1. "A" Priority Items for Irving, Whittier, and Brooks
- 2. Includes Hatch roof, Whittier basement and roof leak issues
- 3. Includes Julian dust collector system and science room (Science as alternate)
- 4. STR identified some small-ticket "A" items not identified at budget meeting with D97 as well as some roofing items.
- 5. Continue to assume that there will be no work at Lincoln and Longfellow (including no roofing) for Summer 2018.

Scope Clarification Questions/Investigative Work

- 1. CO detectors to be wired in.
 - a. Requirement was not part of DLA Life Safety report new code requirement since January 1, 2016.
 - b. Should we include Brooks and Julian with 2018 work? Or provide battery-operated types for the time-being?
 - c. Currently, Beye, Hatch, Holmes and Mann have this (hardwired) installed. We recommend adding this scope for Irving and Whittier at
