A note from the Principal

LSMS' mission is to academically prepare and transition ALL students for high school success! With that mission in mind, the standards for LSMS are rising, and it is no longer acceptable just to do time. During recent assemblies, we have discussed. publically, the expectations about grades and are now implementing as part of our prepare mode of education, the concept that passing grades equate to credits. If a student earns an A, B, C or D in a class, that student earns .33 credits per class, per trimester. Every trimester, a student who is taking six classes and on track, should earn 2 credits (6 classes X .334 credits). A student, who earns 6 credits (2 credits per Trimester X 3 Trimesters) per school year, has shown proficiency at their current grade level and is prepared for the next step in their education.

This "reality check" is being rolled out in a Guide Group activity the week of February 16th. For eighth graders, the reality is this: If an eighth grader wants to participate in all the eighth grade activities at the end of the school year (8th grade dance, 8th grade fun day, adventure day, having their name called at our celebration ceremony etc.), then, that eighth grader needs to earn credit in every class they take during the third trimester.

Because we care, the expectation is: we recognize success, and students attending LSMS will be successful if they choose to. Everyone has a choice; I just hope your son or daughter makes the correct choice.
