SCHOOL DAY

PURPOSE: To ensure the minimum instructional minutes requirement is met

RESPONSIBLE OFFICE: Nye County School District (NCSD) Assistant Superintendent(s)

SCHOOL DAY

The Nye County School District (NCSD) school term will consist of 180 days or equivalent minutes of instruction in accordance with NRS 388.090. The length of the school day will be in keeping with or exceed State requirements. NCSD administration is authorized to make minor changes in opening and closing times to facilitate the scheduling of transportation; however, major changes in school schedules will be subject to the Board of Trustees' (BOT) approval.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at Kindergarten is 120 minutes for 5 day schools.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at Grades 1 and 2 is 240 minutes for 5 day schools.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at Grades 3 through 6 is 300 minutes for 5 day schools.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at Grades 7 through 12 is 330 minutes daily for 5 day schools.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at K-5 will be 368 minutes daily for 4 day schools.

The minimum time devoted to teaching core subjects at 6-12 will be 405 minutes daily for 4 day schools.
