RECOMMENDATION:

Requesting approval for 8 students from the KCTC Health Careers Foundations program and 4 advisors to travel to Fort Wayne, IN on February 20, 2026. This is an opportunity for these students to compete at the Regional Anatomage Competition, held at University of Saint Francis.

BACKGROUND:

This year, we are continuing to grow our anatomy club at KCTC, with 40 students participating on a regular basis. We will hold a KCTC tournament on January 28th and take the top 2 KCTC teams to regionals at the University of St. Francis. The anatomy club focuses on student-driven learning and engagement using the Anatomage table and tablet. The Anatomage table and tablets are advanced 3D anatomy teaching tools that let students explore detailed digital models of the human body, making learning more interactive.

While the competition is a big part of the tournament, there are additional learning opportunities provided to students as part of participating in these experiences. In past years, the University of St. Francis students had the opportunity to learn anatomy in collegiate health and microbiology labs facilitated by graduate health science students and university faculty.

We believe participating in this event is a valuable opportunity for students to further their healthcare knowledge and network with other students with a passion for healthcare.
