Implement academic programs to accelerate the learning of the English language and biliteracy for emergent bilinguals.


Provide research-based professional development and campus support on best instructional practices to meet the needs of emergent bilinguals.

Ensure federal and state guidelines are implemented and supported with proper documentation on the instructional plans for each emergent bilingual.




# Student Enrollment and Participation Overview

- **559** students reclassified at the end of the 2023-2024 school year




# Program Participation


# Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment (TELPAS) Composite score









# Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment (TELPAS) Composite score
