Take the time to ask on the Facebook page Alaskan Homeschoolers to see if anyone else has used it and what they have to say about it.

Third, make sure you have your SLP meeting scheduled with your contact teacher.

Remember, your teacher can help guide you towards curriculum options to look into and research before your SLP meeting.
