August 25, 2025 - Marty Futterman, representing Winter Services requested to know which vendors won the 2024-2025 Snow Removal Bid at all 3 schools, and how much the winning bid was for.

August 26, 2025 - Janie Jordan, representing Data Research Partners LLC requested access to and a copy of all Bloomington School District 13's employees' first and last names, e-mail address, title/position, and primary campus/department location.

September 2, 2025 - Owen Yang, representing Lake County Gazette requested names and honors of all students in your high schools recognized by the College Board as AP Scholars.

September 8, 2025 - Owen Yang, representing Lake County Gazette requested copies of the contracts for all school principals in the district who will start the upcoming school year, and copies of all active teacher contracts/collective bargaining agreements.
