## 2023-2024 Calendar Revision

The SSSD Board of Education and PPC committees approved the conversion to a calendar based on instructional minutes at the February 8, 2024 board meeting.

Each building meets the 1,068 hours (178-day) hourly equivalent with 174 school days.

Northside: 6.3 hours/ 174 days = 1096.2 hours

Allen Elementary: 6.55 hours/174 days = 1139.7 hours

Southside Elementary: 6.38 hours/174 days = 1110.12 hours

Intermediate School: 6.4 hours/174 days = 1113.6 hours

Middle School: 6.17 hours/174 days = 1073 hours

High School/MSA 6.00 hours/105 days; 6.35/69 days = 630 + 438.15 = 1068.15

The number of days for each quarter is revised as follows:

Quarter I: 43 days

Quarter 2: 47 days

Quarter 3: 40 days

Quarter 4: 44 days

TOTAL: 174 days
