Dr. Wilson stated Governor Greg Abbott vetoed SB 313, which would have provided a TEKS review and allowed school districts more flexibility in purchasing instructional materials, but did sign into law HB2398 which decriminalizes truancy and requires school districts to implement truancy prevention measures.
