

WBOE Committee Priorities 2018-19

Policy:

- 1) Re-review of all policies, using CABE suggestions to degree possible (similar to process done when Matt Gilbride was Policy Chair)
- 2) Identify policies relating to mission/vision and update as needed, or create policy if not in existence (from Board Self Review Meeting)

Facilities

- 1) New priority list of grounds projects, costs, and timeframes
- 2) Facilities Assessment report and implementation (outside consultant from Amity)
- 3) BRS Building Committee report and implementation
- 4) Capital budget projects/estimates
- 5) School Capacity issues – Discussion of current limits, program impacts, update to Town
- 6) Energy Savings Report – due in September

Finance:

- 1) Budget Considerations for 2019-20:
 - i) Additional administrative position(s).
 - ii) Enrichment coach/specialist, or other recommendation from Ad Hoc Enrichment Committee
 - iii) Additional Special Education or School psychologist staffing based on Student and Staff surveys of behavior in classrooms
 - iv) Possible maintenance or material costs to restoring/improving outdoor classroom areas.
 - v) Supply funding for any missing recycle bins.
- 2) Discussion of school capacity issues, upper limits of classrooms, cost impact
- 3) Get feedback from BOF Liaison (Sandy Stein) on expectations from Town BOF

Curriculum:

- 1) Curriculum cycle by subject
- 2) “Think tank” on Social Studies - already done partly by Library/Media, Language Arts, etc.
- 3) School Wide Enrichment continued implementation and information to parents
- 4) Math Curriculum implementation/math workshop model
- 5) Curriculum enrichment outside of school hours (examples):
 - a) Robotics
 - b) Math Olympiad
 - c) Math Counts (gr. 6)
 - d) Poetry Guild
 - e) Culture
 - f) Computer Coding
