

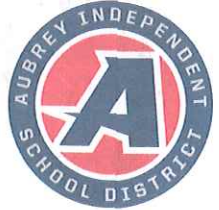

Aubrey ISD Police Department: September Board Communication

Honorable School Board Members:

Here are some of the highlights from the Aubrey ISD Police Department for the month of August 2015.

- I am pleased to write you this letter to give you the updates of the Aubrey ISD PD. So far for the school year we have deployed our K-9 4 Times for K-9 Searches on campus, with no narcotics found and no alerts. We have also made 7 sporting events, and lastly done 5 K-9 demonstrations for class presentations. Within the first week of school we deployed to one of our campuses. I hope that we are well on our way to having no narcotics cases this year on campus.
- Second good news is during the first week of school we had very minor traffic issues, for our biggest rush of the year. Officer Jacobs (Part time officer) was stationed at Brockett elementary school for traffic control, while I directed traffic at the Middle School.
- As the football season has started we have also started traffic control after football games to gets the fans out faster and safer than before. We are doing more at the games this year, and working harder to serve our community, students, and visitors.
- Early this year, I transitioned to the role of emergency management coordinator for the district. Since this I have been working hard to learn the role, and be able to fill some pretty big shoes. Recently while working with the Texas School Safety Center, I have updated our emergency Operation Plans, for the whole district to better serve not only our needs but our community.
- In the beginning of August, Aubrey ISD PD on behalf of our drug prevention task force also hosted another parent information meeting, on "What caring parents need to know about drug awareness." We had about twenty parents show up for this presentation.
- Aubrey ISD along with some of our surrounding agencies has purchased the Copsync system to be able to better keep track of our calls for service, citations/warnings, security checks, racial profiling, and lastly reports. My goal this year is to provide you with a better picture of what we do, and the call volume that we handle.
- Recently I have started the AISD PD reserve / part time program. This provides us officers that will work a minimum of sixteen hours per month, for free. This program

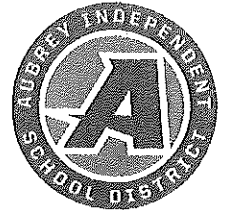
