The vice president shall preside over meetings in the absence of the president and shall be the chairperson of the fund-raising committee. The secretary will keep accurate minutes at all meetings and be in charge of all correspondence and paper work. The treasurer will keep accurate records of all financial transactions and balance the club account with the staff advisor on a regular basis. 			
	Elections will be held at the first convened meeting of the school year.			
E.	<u>MEETINGS</u> The president or staff advisor, as needed, will call meetings.			
F.	<u>REMOVAL OF OFFICERS</u> Officers may be removed by a 3/4 vote of the membership at an official meeting.			
G.	<u>AMENDMENTS</u> This constitution can be amended by a 2/3 vote of the membership at a regular meeting.			
Н.	<u>POWER OF THE PRINCIPAL</u> All provisions of this constitution and decisions made by the club are subject to veto by the Principal or the designee.			
I.	QUORUM A quorum of 51% is required in order to transact business.
