# Summer Projects, Personnel Needs, and Temporary Employees

## **Background:**

The staff has been compiling lists of cleaning, maintenance, and improvement ideas for summer projects. Highlights appear below:

□ Replace carpet in approximately eight classrooms.	\$20,000
□ Fix broken football field lights.	\$5,000
□ Replace pea gravel near track with sod.	\$5,000
□ Routine repairs to restrooms.	\$5,000
□ Bury the football field water sprinkler hook-up.	\$2,000
□ Install lights above the welding booths on the wire welder side.	\$3,000
□ Check for roof leaks and seal potential holes.	\$8,000
□ Carpet cleaning in all classrooms	\$5,000
□ Install ventilation/exhaust in Ms. Meints FACS kitchen area.	\$10,000
□ Rain gutter attached to the greenhouse.	\$1,000
□ Replace all stained ceiling tiles.	\$300
□ Cultivate sod on playground and football practice field.	\$5,000
□ Refinish the two gymnasium floors.	\$7,000
□ Repainting the lines in the parking lot.	\$1,000
□ Repainting classrooms according to the master schedule.	\$2,000
□ Renovate the shop area restrooms and sinks.	\$5,000
□ Student desks need to undergo routine cleaning and repair.	
□ Lockers cleaned out, mechanisms oiled, and graffiti removed.	
Miscellaneous small and routine cleaning, maintenance, wiring, and plumbing projects.	\$9,000
TOTAL COST	\$93,300
