Proposals were submitted by two companies, The Brandt Companies and C&G Electrical. Each proposal was evaluated by the committee consisting of Paul Andress, Kathy Arrington and Cheryl Farmer. With a Master Electrician rarely used, the vendor selected for recommendation is the best value for the district.
