



PUBLIC CONTRACTS – BOARD AUTHORIZATION OF SUPERINTENDENT TO OBLIGATE THE DISTRICT

POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On June 1, 2009, the Board adopted current policy language regarding Authority to Obligate the District (Board Policy DJ), which updates the School District's Public Contracting Rules in accordance with State Recommended Model Rules. Appropriate bidding procedures and Public Contracting Rules have been complied with before recommending the attached contract for Board approval. The following authorization of contract, subject to available budget appropriations, is a routine Board action that appears under the consent grouping of the Board agenda.

PROJECT NAME: New Comprehensive High School at South Cooper Mountain

PROJECT TIMELINE: 7/2015 – 6/15/2017

PROJECT BUDGET: \$146,409,000

PROJECT SCOPE: Construction of a new comprehensive High School with a design capacity of 2,200 students comprised of a predominately three story (4 story on one side) building with approximately 339,000 square feet including site development of 47 acres.

SUBCONTRACT NAME: Pre-GMP change order, bid package #2B.2 Steel and #2B.3 Masonry to the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) - Hoffman Construction Company

SUBSOLICITATION METHOD: Public Bid Package #2B, Core & Shell – Prepared by Hoffman Construction administered by BSD

SUBCONTRACT TIMELINE: Substantial completion June 15, 2017

SUBCONTRACT AMOUNT: Bid Package 2B.2 – Steel \$7,490,979

Bid Package 2B.3 - Masonry \$10,424,045

SUBCONTRACT SCOPE: Due to the project schedule and anticipated school opening in September of 2017, early bid packages are necessary to solicit and award portions of work prior to establishment of the GMP (Guaranteed Maximum Price). This portion represents the work involved in installing/erecting the core structure including: Structural Steel, Framing & Decking, Metal stairs & fabrications, Pre-Cast Concrete, Brick & Concrete Unit Masonry. These items are long fabrication and lead time and need authorization to be awarded to keep the project on schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorization of Change Order to Hoffman Construction Company to allow award of this work – Bid Package #2B.2 Steel & #2B.3 Masonry

FUNDING SOURCE: 2014 Bond, New Capacity, New High School

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
