These student-athletes will get to see how the sport of lacrosse is played at the highest levels in the NCAA up-close, and the boys in our program that aspire to play lacrosse at the collegiate level will get a first-hand view of what Division I NCAA lacrosse looks like.

How:

Cost | Group tickets for a group of 20+ are \$2/ticket. Students will be expected to purchase their own ticket and provide themselves with breakfast prior to getting on the bus. We will plan to either eat at the stadium or stop for a meal on the way back for the group. In addition to the cost of the ticket, students will need to bring money for themselves for one meal.
