On February 2, 2022, a sixth donation totaling \$71,400 was received from Mylan Company for Epi-Pens 2-Pak (Epinephrine) Auto-Injectors 0.3mg and Epi-Pen Jr 2-Pak (Epinephrine) Auto-Injectors 0.15mg. These Epi-Pens 2-Pak are worth \$700.00 each and the district received a total of 51 boxes of pediatric Epi-pens and 51 boxes of adult Epi-pens for 102 boxes. These Epi-pens will be distributed to all campuses to provide emergency care during a severe allergic reaction (Anaphylaxis) which can be life threatening. When a PTO or Booster Club donates monetary or non-monetary items to the District, then the donation is considered a contribution to the District.
