Dean Activities:

- **Attendance Tardies:** As of today 9/10/2018 the attendance is better than at the same time last year see attached. The goal is to maintain attendance at 88% overall we currently are at 89% for the school. Three students that were roll overs from the previous years will be dropped and 1 student choose to quit attending school.
- **Discipline.** The referrals I have gotten so far have been stage 1 behaviors or class management issues and the process for handling these issues are laid out and follow a progression. What is fast becoming the norm the busiest days so far are Mondays: students who use Facebook inappropriately bring the drama to school. Parents are usually unaware of the students and how their students are using Facebook. There currently no students on behavior contract. 6 students have been suspended for fighting. 1 student has been suspended for Bully Harassment and Intimidation. There have been no tier 1 or tier 2 wright up from the Jr. High.
- **Bullying Prevention:** as of today the students of the Jr. High and the High School have Covered the student handbook in their respective English classes. The intervention process is still in place and has been successful in investigating, addressing and deterring bullying behavior. I have intervened on 5 reported cases of bullying all of which had roots in social media (Face Book, Snap Chat etc.) 4 of the 5 have been resolved and 1 ended in suspension.
- **Duties:** the duty schedule that I maintain is rigorous and consumes the majority of my time, I attempt to walk the halls at least twice a period and observe at least every class once in the morning and once in the afternoon logging 6.5 miles daily.
- **Student Recognition:** the “Star Student” program is still in place with the continuation of the star board tied to rewards. Student of the week process is continuing to develop however the continuity is in its infancy I will strive to work out the details.
