- In the month of July 2018, it was a quiet month for the Good Medicine Program staff members.
- There was no scheduled Youth Mental Health First Aid training in the month of June, but after request we will now have a training in July 2018.
- Two of the Good Medicine Program staff members and one community suicide grant coordinator attended and are now trained to be ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills training) trainers for the community. The training provides individuals with the communication skills to help people at risk with an intervention to stay safe for now and to get resources set up in place to assist the person.
- The Good Medicine Program staff members helped with recruiting students for the BAWAP camp/hikes.
- Several of the GMP staff members also assisted with the Tamarack Grief Camps, which were two and a half days.
