Re: Student Information System (SIS) Purchase Recommendation

During the March 10<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting, the district presented a recommendation to move forward with the purchase and implementation of Synergy SIS from Edupoint. This recommendation seeks the Board's formal consideration to move forward with this recommendation.

The process to arrive at this recommendation included multiple SIS solution reviews, involved dozens of staff from the district, and considered the greatest challenges and needs of the district. As a result of the process, Synergy SIS emerged as the recommendation. If approved, the implementation of this product would begin as early as June 1, 2025 and continue throughout the 2025-26 school year. Formal go-live is set for the start of the 2026-27 school year.

The costs associated with Years 2-5 are fixed costs. The costs for Year 1 reflect estimates for the professional services time and resources to support the transition. Due to the nature and complexity of this project, the district is seeking a total project budget of \$569,338. The increase in costs from those presented on March 10 are attributable to 11 additional years of data conversion, software escrow services ( $3^{rd}$  Party Software Services), and budget allowance.

All agreements are pending Board approval and the finalization of contractual terms and conditions.
