

As you know the Livonia Public Schools' *Golden Apple Award* recognizes outstanding contributions of time, talent or effort in support of the students, parents, and staff of the Livonia Public Schools. I strongly support the recognition of Lynn Neavill as a *Golden Apple Award* recipient.

Ms. Neavill has a grandchild who attends Garfield Elementary School. For the past five years, Ms. Neavill has been a regular volunteer in her grandson's classroom and at school functions. In addition, the past four years has seen Ms. Neavill coordinate our Basket Raffle at our annual *School Celebration Night*. This takes tremendous amount of organization and time to make happen. What wonderful excitement fills our school as classrooms under the direction of Ms. Neavill create classroom baskets to raffle in support of our PTA.

Approximately two years ago, our school's *Literacy Team* determined that our school *Leveled Literacy Bookroom* needed updating. We had attempted many different methods to get the work done, but the project just didn't seem to get off the ground. That is until Ms. Neavill took over! Over the next year, Ms. Neavill organized our bookroom, inventoried every book, determined reading levels of books that weren't previously leveled, and relocated the bookroom to a more central location in the building. I can't tell you for sure how many hours of her time that Ms. Neavill contributed, but I can tell you she inventoried over 12,000 books, labeled each book, and created a bookroom that is fully functional and has benefited student learning by ensuring that the right books are getting into the right child's hands. Furthermore, due to her work we can now easily analyze where potential shortages of leveled books or types of genres may exist within our inventory. As mentioned above, our bookroom is fully functional. Yet Ms. Neavill's work is not done! She has plans in partnership with our school's media specialist to barcode every book in our bookroom.
