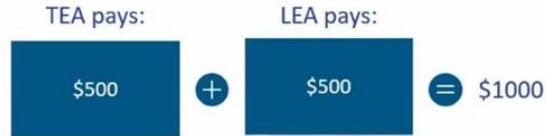
# Detail | Bulk order matching funds

## TEA will match the funds that LEAs put towards the bulk order

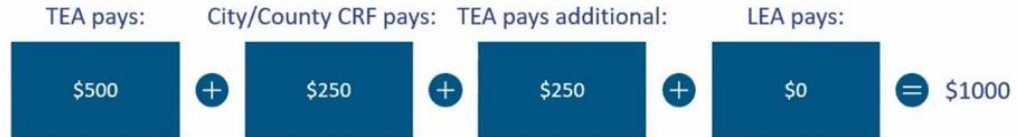

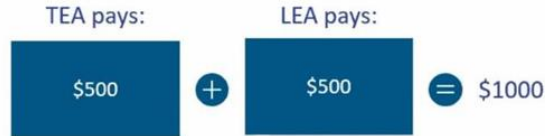

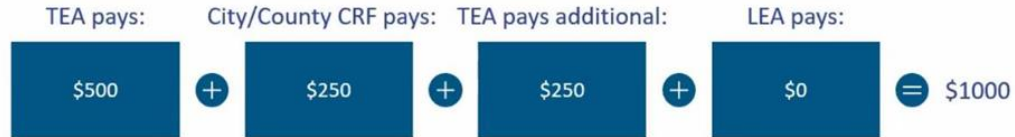
