Agenda Item Caption: Consideration of a Resolution to Apply for the Active Attack Response Equipment Grant

Purpose of Agenda Item: Action needed

Administrative Recommendation: Move to approve the proposed resolution to apply for the Active Attack Response Equipment Grant, as presented.

Background Information: The office of the Governor has approved state funds in the amount of \$15 million for the bullet resistant shield grant program for the fiscal year 2027 to provide ballistic shields to law enforcement agencies employing peace officers. The state funds were authorized by a Budget Execution Order proposed by the Texas Legislative Budget Board and ratified by Governor Abbott on June 28, 2022. The funding announcement was released on December 15, 2025, and the deadline to submit the grant application is February 12, 2026.

Fiscal Analysis: Killeen ISD will be submitting a request for ballistic shields to be used in the KISD Police Department. The total costs of the shields will be funded through the Governor's Office grant with no requirement of matching funds from the district.

Requirement: All officers provided with a grant-funded ballistic shield must have either attended 16 hours of ALERRT (Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training) training within the last 24 months or commit to attend within the next 24 months.
