- a. New Teacher Orientation: Mr. Wright reviewed the schedule for the new teacher orientation sessions this week. There are 12 new teachers this year.

- c. Opening of School: The start of school will take place August 4 with all-day Teacher Institute. Link Crew (freshman only) will happen August 6, with all students returning August 7. Freshman Welcome Night will be held August 7 from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. New Employee reception will be August 11 beginning at 5 p.m. in the Commons.

8. Comptroller's Report (Janice Roome) (BP 3:10)

- a. Request approval for repair and resurfacing of tennis courts: Ms. Roome recommends the Board approve the proposal for repair and resurfacing of the tennis courts in July 2026. She expects approval for grant monies through the United States Tennis Association to assist with the costs. Dr. Morrow expressed appreciation for Dr. John Feehan's efforts toward this project.
- b. Request approval of the tentative FY26 UTHS District 30 budget: Ms. Roome presented the tentative budget, noting this is a conservative, best guess for revenues and expenditures. The final budget will be presented in September for approval. The district will have a better picture of state and federal funding after final approvals are made.

Girls Swim Athletic Cooperative: Dr. Morrow presented the proposed cooperative agreement with Port Byron (Riverdale) school district allowing participation as UT athletes on the girls swim team. Can absorb additional athletes coming in. The administration will develop a plan for cooperative athletes to comply with UT's athletic code.
