Issue Summary:

Administration is requesting that the members of the Board of Education approve a Type M teacher certification request for the following individuals who hold Iñupiat Language Teacher positions:

This candidates' skills and qualifications based on work history, training, and expertise in the Iñupiaq language and culture merit the Type M teacher certificate.

Background:

The North Slope Borough School District has offered contracts to David Elavgak as the Iñupiaq Language Teacher of Barrow High School and to Brandi Akpik as the Iñupiat Language Teacher of Kiita Learning Community for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Prior Board approval is required by the Alaska Department of Education in addition to other specified requirements in order for teachers to be granted Type M certificates.
